An offering of apple butter and dark bread is made to the Outdwellers and is laid beyond the perimeter of the ritual space prior to hallowing and claiming. The Sacrificer will lay the offerings. All participants assemble for the Grove Attunement just outside of the Nemeton.

GROVE ATTUNEMENT (Eld Naðr)

Closing your eyes, take a few deep cleansing breaths.

Breathing in through your nose and out through your mouth.

In through your nose and out through your mouth.

As you breath, lay aside the worries, troubles and woes of the mundane world. *(pause 4 count)*

You now stand between Earth and Sky

Feel your feet firmly resting upon the Earth

Know that below you flows the primal waters

Cold, dark and chaotic; filled with the potential of all life.

Allow the primal waters to enter your being.

Feel the coolness of the waters as they pool within your belly, within your heart and finally, within your head. *(pause 8 count)*

Reaching high into the sky above

Feel the illuminating radiance of the Heavens

Know that above you burns the primal fires

Warm, light and ordered; filled with the spark of all life.

Allow the primal fire to enter your being.

Feel the warmth of the fires as they illuminate your mind, your heart and finally your spirit. *(pause 8 count)*

Feel the primal powers of Earth and Sky as they surge through you, lending strength and energy to your being. *(pause 8 count)*

As we open our eyes, know that we assemble as one folk to worship with a common purpose.

All:

May our worship be true.
May our actions be just.
May our love be pure.
Blessings, honor and worship to the Holy Ones.

PROCESSIONAL (Carrion)

In song

To gather together at the sacred well
Come we now as a people

CLAIMING AND HALLOWING (Moondragon)

The days grow longer and the sun's power strengthens, as the green world blossoms with new life.

A warm wind blows across the fertile land and the gentle rain nurtures the new growth. Winter's frigid winds may have been driven from this land, yet the threat of fearsome storms remains.

Once more we shall meet the threat of chaos with order and lay claim to this place. We shall make sacred this space and time that we may worship and honor the Kindred as one people.

Outdwellers (at the Southern fire) (Raven)

Dark dwellers, take heed this night!
Know the Mighty Tuatha will ward this place!
Their treasures will strike order from choas!
Driving all that is twisted and bent into the darkness.

Balor of the Evil Eye; King of the Fomorians,
who has dared to challenge the Might and Magic of the Tuatha.
You and your kin, primal bringers chaos and discord,
Hoards, whose screams and cries, harmonize not with our songs
and praise.

Dark dwellers, take heed this night!
This time and place we claim as ours!
You may have held it in the past, you may hold it in the future,
but for now,
Let it be known that it is OURS!

We have given to you all that we intend to give.
Take what has been laid beyond the fire's light
And trouble us not this night!

Consecration of Sacred Time & Space (Carrion)

In the beginning and so too in the end; there was but the fires of the Sky and the waters of the Earth. And between them lay a fertile land.

In the South the old Fir Bog King, dreamed of birds, the sky grew dark as the great flock approached the shore.

From the North through smoke and mist came beings of great might and magic, the vast army of the Tuatha to overtake the land. Bringing with them four treasures that would assure their victory. Reaching the shore, the Tuatha burnt their ships and a great battle for the land began. Great numbers of the Fir Bolg fell as the armies of the Tuatha swept across the land. In defeat the Fir Bolg retreated to the lands of the Formorians and the Tuatha De Danannan lay claim to Ireland.

Claiming Place

Begin in the North saying:

Out of Falias the Stone of Fal, herald of the rightful king, Stone of Sovereignty, hallow and hold this holy ground. **(Moondragon)**

Facing East:

Out of Findas, the Sword of Nuada, never to be defeated in battle, Sword of Justice, hallow and hold this holy ground. **(Eld Naðr)**

Facing South:

Out of Glorias, the Spear of Lugh, which turns the tide of battle, Mighty Spear, hallow and hold this holy ground. **(Carrion)**

Facing West:

Out of Murias, the Cauldron of the Dagda, from which none go hungry, Cauldron of Plenty, hallow and hold this holy ground. **(Raven)**

From the Center of the Hallows:

Great Treasures of the Tuatha hallow and hold this holy ground! **(Moondragon)**

To the Middle realm. (Eld Naðr)

Kindred of the Land, hallow and hold this holy ground.

And then to the realm below: (Carrion)

Kindred of the Sea, hallow and hold this holy ground.

To the realm above: (Raven)

Kindred of the Sky, hallow and hold this holy ground.

Finally, center the forces by folding your arms in from the cross position with your fingers touching at the solar plexus and say:

The aspersing bowl is filled by Chris T. from the Well and the censer is kindled from the Fire by Moondragon. The Nemeton is censed and asperged as the following words are chanted by all participants. Grove members participating in the hallowing and claiming are also censed and asperged at this time.

An offering of nine sacred woods is made.

(Moon Dragon) The Ancients, our Ancestors, would purify themselves, in, between and over these fires to prepare for the season of fertility. We no longer purify ourselves within the fire, but we invite you now to dance between the fires in celebration of the coming season.

A drum beat begins and all have an opportunity to be purified

between the fires.

(Raven) The Queen and King of the Sidhe rule from deep within the Hollow Hills. Aine, Mistress of Unbridled Passion and Aengus, the Chosen One of the Tuatha. Before you, we will forge our alliances with the Noble Ones.

(Raven) In the Old days alliances with the Faery Folk were made by tying of bright strips of cloth in the branches of the sacred trees. This May Eve as the veil stands thin we prepare to forge our own alliances with the Sidhe.

(Raven) Come Good Folk, to our Faery Tree and tie a cloutie among the branches, so that it may stand for your alliance with the Noble Ones during this season of fertility.

All are given an opportunity to tie clouties to the faery tree.

(Carrion Mann) Now let us offer our praise to the Kindred.

with. **(pause for 2 count)** Feel the presence of the Noble Spirits as we await their message. **(pause for 2 count)**

We send our love, honor and respect deep into the Sacred Well to the Mighty Dead, our ancestors of blood and of spirit, it is their timeless wisdom that inspires us to strive always to better ourselves and our world around us. **(pause for 2 count)** Feel the presence of the Mighty Dead as we await their guidance. **(pause for 2 count)**

We send our love, honor and respect through the Sacred Fire into the heavens to the Shining Ones, Eldest and Wisest. **(pause for 4 count)** It is their guidance and blessings we seek. Feel the presence of the Shining Ones as we await their blessings. **(pause for 2 count)**.

(Raven)(Eld Naðr)

The Omen is taken. One Ogham is drawn for each of the three Kindred. The seer then interprets the omen, leading the company to contemplate the things they would ask of the powers, especially as suggested by the omen.

(Carrion) We will drink deep of the Cup of Inspiration. May the blessings of health, wealth and wisdom be ours.

(Carrion) We gather with you between Earth and Sky. We are proud to call ourselves your people.

(Raven) Once again, Shining Ones your blessings upon us!

(Eld Naðr) Mighty Kindred of land, sea and sky, Eldest, Wisest and Mightiest of the realms. May you continue to protect, guide and bless us as we walk this path.
