

GROVE ATTUNEMENT (OUR JOURNEY BEGINS) (Isaura)

Closing your eyes, take a few deep cleansing breaths.

Breathing in through your nose and out through your mouth.

In through your nose and out through your mouth.

As you breathe, lay aside the worries, troubles and woes of the mundane world. (pause 4 count)

We now stand between Earth and Sky

Feel your feet firmly resting upon the Earth

Know that below us flows the primal waters

Cold, dark and chaotic; filled with the potential of all life.

Allow the primal waters to enter your being.

Feel the coolness of the waters as they pool within your belly, within your heart and finally, within your head. (pause 8 count)

Reaching high into the sky above
Feel the illuminating radiance of the Heavens
Know that above us burns the primal fires
Warm, light and ordered; filled with the spark of all life.

Allow the primal fire to enter your being.

Feel the warmth of the fires as they illuminate your mind, your heart and finally your spirit. (pause 8 count)

Now join your hands, your hearts and your minds as one people. (All participants join hands)

Feel the primal powers of Earth and Sky as they surge through you, lending strength and energy to your being. (pause 8 count)

(Carrion)

As we begin our journey among the Alfar, we shall do so with the protection of the Earth, the guidance of the Sky and with the support of the Sea that surrounds us.

The sun is beginning to set; casting shadows among the trees that lie before you. In the distance you see the entrance to a pathway through the trees. The spirits of Nature call to you, their many voices gently whispering upon the wind beaconing you to approach.

You slowly approach the head of the path and begin to follow the trail until it opens into a small clearing amidst the trees. As you enter the clearing, the setting sun feels warm upon your back....

Before you a hill rises to meet the setting sun. This mound is covered in a blanket of green and obvious signs of fall's approach are visible in the remnants of summer's once brilliant flowers. The mound rises high above your head, you can see the side of

the hill and what lies above it; but what lies unseen and hidden within.

As we open our eyes, know that we now journey as one folk with a common purpose.

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE (Carrion)

Purpose of the Ritual

Once more closing your eyes and breathing deeply, in through your nose and out through your mouth, in through your nose and out through your mouth...

Once more immediately before you the mound rises high above your head. The setting sun has cast a shadow upon the face of the mound. For a moment you watch in silence as the shadows fade from light to dark and dark to light... in what appears to be almost a dance upon the side of the mound.

The dancing shadows fade and a circular mist begins to form on the face of the mound. Through the mist you begin to see the rocky surface beneath. As it swirls the mist fades and you see within the surface of the mound a very small entrance in the clearing, but what lies hidden within... You hear the faint sound of laughter and music emanating from the mound. You fear what is hidden and unseen, so you watch and listen quietly. Waiting, watching and listening you feel your heart beating with anticipation in your chest. You conquer your fear and step toward the entrance of the mound. Swirling mist once more covers the entrance. Opening your eyes...

The aspersing bowl is filled by Isaura. from the Well and the censer is kindled from the Fire by Chris G. Ritual participants are cleansed with water from the well and purified with smoke from the censor. After the participants are cleansed and purified the Nemeton is cleansed and purified as the following power building chant is led by Grollwynn.

With the powers to create and destroy.

And the strength to cleanse and purify.

When all participants have been purified Raven will step forward saying:

Our Nemeton is made whole and holy!

Once more swirling mist covers the entrance of the mound before you. You hear the faint sound of music and laughter as before. You hope for a glimpse of what lies hidden within, but you can not see despite the entrance to the mound growing larger in the

whirling mist. You will need help to see beyond the mist and into the howe. Let us open our eyes and call to those that dwell within the mound.

It is our hope that our words and sacrifice have conveyed our love

We call once more through the Gates and deep within the Otherworld that all shall know of our devotion.

The final sacrifice is made.

Alfar, accept our sacrifice!

THE OMEN

(Raven)

The Omen is taken by drawing three Runes. The seer then interprets the omen asking if our sacrifice and offerings have been accepted. The Seer then leads the company to contemplate the blessings/warnings of the omen from the Deities of the Occasion.

Participants chant the following, sending their energies through the gates.

(Carrion)

Once more closing your eyes and breathing deeply, in through your nose and out through your mouth, in through your nose and out through your mouth...

Once more swirling mist covers the entrance of the mound before you. You hear the faint sound of music and laughter as before. As you focus your attention upon the entrance to the howe and the swirling mist, a white misty figure forms within the doorway. You see this ghostly figure step from the mist an into the clearing before you! An overwhelming feeling of peace and abundance fills you. The figure of a mighty warrior stands before you. He is beautiful. His hair is black, his skin dark and eyes green, yet he is surrounded by a golden light. His strength is evident in his form. He does not speak, but reaches out his closed hand to you and you extend yours to meet his. You feel the weight of an object in your palm. As your attention turns toward this object, the figure fades returning once more through the mist and into the howe before you. The object you have been given is a wholly stone. As if second nature you hold this stone to your eye and once more view the entrance to the mound. The mist instantly begins to clear and what has lies hidden and unseen is revealed to you...

After a few moments you remove the wholly stone from your eye and hold it tightly within your hand. The mist returns sealing the entrance to the howe. You spend a few moments considering what has been reveal to you...knowing the Alfar have shared their wisdom and hidden knowledge with each of us. Freyr has given us the key to build an alliance with our Ancestors...a tool to use when we are in need of the might and magic of the Alfar. Entrance to the world of the Alfar has been entrusted to each of us. Let us forever remember the old bargain and keep this wisdom close. As we open our eyes...Let us prepare to receive the Blessings of the Alfar.

THE BLESSING (Raven) (Carrion)

Two pitchers will be filled and sat in the midst of the hallows. The following words will be spoken over the pitchers.

(Raven) As in the ways of old we have given our gifts freely and as in the ways of old a gift is given unto us in return.

(Carrion) We will drink deep of the Cup of Inspiration. May the blessings of health, wealth and wisdom be ours.

(Raven) Alfar your blessings upon us!

All: Alfar your blessings upon us!

(Carrion) We gather with you at the mound. We are proud to call ourselves your people.

(Raven) Once again, Alfar your blessings upon us!

All: Alfar your blessings upon us!

(Carrion) We have brought our offerings. We have made sacrifice.

(Raven) One last time, Alfar your blessings upon us!

All: Alfar your blessings upon us!

(Grollwynn) The pitchers are lifted saluting the fire, well and tree.

(Raven) Alfar, Wise Ones of the Mound, Bringers of Bounty, hallow these Waters of Life.

AFFIRMATION OF THE BLESSINGS

(Raven) Now Good folk, do you wish to receive the blessings Freyr and the Alfar have for us this night? _____. Then we shall drink deep there blessings!

The Waters are passed (Isaura & Chris F.) and all participants share the waters. As the waters are passed the following song is sung by all participants.

(Grollwynn) As we receive the blessing of the Alfar let us raise our voices in song.

(Raven) Odin, One Eyed Wanderer; we thank you for your protection and guidance this night. (a final token is offered) May there be peace between us until we meet once again by the hearth's fire

(Carrion) We now return all that has gone unused to the Earth and the Sky, may they continue to support, surround and sustain us. All offerings that remain are burnt in the fire or scattered upon the Earth.

STATEMENT OF ENDING

Unmerging, Regrounding & Recentering: Meditation

(Isaura) Good folk, join me once more as we close our eyes; breathing deeply in through your nose and out through your mouth (pause for a 2 count).

As the mighty ash is part of the forest, we are all part of the great circle of life. Remember the blessings we have received together this night (pause).

As we stand between Earth and Sky

Once more feel your feet firmly resting upon the Earth

Know that below us flows the primal waters.

Once more feel the coolness of the waters that have pooled within your belly, within your heart and finally, within your head. (pause 4 count)

Reaching high into the sky above

Feel the illuminating radiance of the Heavens.

Know that above us burns the primal fires.

Once more feel the warmth of the fires that have illuminated your mind, your heart and finally your spirit. (pause 4 count)

Feel the primal powers of Earth and Sky surging through you, as they have given strength and energy to your being. (pause 4 count)

Keep of this power what you need, sending what remains forth from our beings into the Great Lake (pause). See this energy heal and protect her as we conclude our worship.

(Carrion)

The sun has set; the shadows sleep once more among the trees that lie before you. In the distance you see a pathway through the trees. The spirits of Nature call to you, their many voices gently whispering upon the wind beaconing you to approach.

You slowly approach the path and once more follow the trail until it opens into a clearing beyond the trees. As you enter the clearing, you feel the presence of those that have journeyed with you this night....As you open your eyes...
