

Grove Attunement Ritual participants gather above the Nemeton for the Attunement lead by AeonOHorus and Sidhe Wolf.

(AeonOHorus) Joining hands and closing your eyes, take a few deep, cleansing breaths in through your nose and out through your mouth; (pause for a 4 count) in through your nose and out through your mouth (pause for a 4 count). As you breathe, begin to slow your busy thoughts (pause for a 4 count).

(AeonOHorus) Feel your feet firmly resting upon the Earth. Imagine that from your feet roots begin to grow (pause for a 2 count). See your roots as they break through the fertile Earth in search of the primal waters. (pause for a 4 count) Feel your roots as they reach the swift current of the primal waters (pause for a 4 count).

(Sidhe Wolf) With each breath, draw this current up through your roots and into your body. (pause for a 4 count) As you breathe, draw this ancient power through your trunk and into your belly. Feel its power as it pools there, restoring you and lending strength to your being (pause for a 4 count). Draw this ancient power into your heart. Feel this ancient energy as it too begins to pool, restoring you and lending strength to your being. (pause for a 4 count) Finally, draw the primal waters into your head. Feel this ancient power as it pools there, restoring you and lending strength to your being.

(AeonOHorus) Turning your attention Skyward, extending your arms high into the sky above (pause for a 2 count). Feel your arms begin to lengthen like the branches of the mighty oak. See your branches reaching the depths of the cosmos. (pause for a 4 count) Feel the primal power of the Sun; of the Moon and of the Stars. (pause for a 4 count)

(AeonOHorus) A flash of electric energy rushes toward you. Feel this electric power of the Sky as it illuminates your mind and mingles with the Earth power in your head. (pause for a 4 count). As you breath, draw this illuminating energy into your heart. See the Sky power as it ignites the primal waters. Feel this power as it illuminates and energizes your being. (pause for a 4 count) Finally, draw this energy into your belly. See this illuminating energy ignite the awaiting waters. Feel the power of the Sky as it illuminates and energizes your being.

(Sidhe Wolf) Feel the power of Earth and Sky as the energies surge within you. Feel the strength and balance this power brings to you (pause for a 4 count).

(AeonOHorus) Opening your eyes, see all who have joined together this night as one tribe and one people (pause for a 2 count). Feel the harmony that surrounds you as we begin our worship between the Earth and Sky.

Processional Song

Seasonal Enactment

Following the Seasonal Enactment, ritual participants are given an opportunity to make praise offerings in the form of poetry, song, dance, or works of their hands etc. Please avoid

clapping after praise offerings.

(Sidhe Wolf) For our ancestors the time of Lughnassadh was the time of the first harvest. The time when the first grains of barley were ground and baked into bread. The hunger had ended and the tribe could look forward to the bountiful season of harvest. The crops were still in danger of blight, frost or hail. This could mean a lean, hard winter to come.

The ancients sacrificed to the Dark, Bent One, Crom Dubh, that he may stay his hand until the harvest ended at Samhain. This is the time that the young bull vanquishes the old. The time when Lugh stands as guardian for the survival of the tribe. A survival that relies on a good harvest.

(Raven Mann) Champion come forward and receive your weapon.

The Champion is handed the Spear of Lugh. (The Champion will be selected during the pre-briefing by the drawing of lots).

(Sidhe Wolf) At Beltaine you were the "Hawk of May", but today your are the mighty young bull, protector of the clan and tribe. The old bull awaits your coming. He is prepared for his time of rest. His sacrifice signals the beginning of the reaping. Through his sacrifice may we enjoy a bountiful season of harvest.

The Champion cuts off the head of the old bull (The old bull is made of bread!) AeonOHorus will gather the head and place it on a tray. The Champion followed by AeonOHoruswill process the head once around the Nemeton for all to see. AeonOHorus will place among the Hallows.

(Sidhe Wolf) The harvest is in and the hunger is over!

(Raven Mann) Good Folk, bring forth the first of the harvest!

Ritual participants will come forth and take first fruits of the harvest, placing them upon the tray containing the old bulls head. Once all items have been placed.

(Sidhe Wolf) The old bull now travels to his place of rest.

The Sacrificer proceeded by the Champion will take the tray to its final resting place by the head of Crom at the top of the hill above the Nemeton. Once the offering has been made.

(Raven Mann) Crom, the land will soon be yours once again, we ask that you accept this gift, the first of the harvest, that you may stay your hand awhile longer.

(Sidhe Wolf) The young bull may now ascend to his rightful place.

The Champion comes forward to the Hallows, spear in hand.

The Sacrificer removes the body of the old bull and the Champion replaces the bull's body with the spear.

(Raven Mann) Mighty Champion of the Folk; Hero of the Tuatha. Master of the Arts. Bright Lugh, bless our growing fields that we may reap a good harvest.

(Carrion) Now let us offer our praise to the Kindred.

Praise Offerings

Ritual participants are given an opportunity to make praise offerings in the form of poetry, song, dance, or works of their hands etc. Please avoid clapping after praise offerings.

(AeonOhorus)

Through Manannan MacLir, Great Warder and Guardian of the Ways, we have opened the Gates this night.

A final sacrifice is prepared. (AeonOhorus)

Participants meditate on the kindred, sending their energies through the gates.

(Moondragon) As we have gathered here as one people, joining hearts and minds we see those we have honored this night. We feel their presence and hear their whispers from the Otherworld.

We send our love, honor and respect into the Middle realm to the Noble Spirits, our protectors and guides. It is their secret knowledge and companionship that we strive to share and be one with. May they feel our love; see our sincerity and hear our praise in their honor. (pause for 2 count) Feel the presence of the Noble Spirits. (pause) Hear their whispers as we await their message.

(Sidhe Wolf)

We send our love, honor and respect deep into the Sacred Well to the Mighty Dead, our ancestors of blood and of spirit, it is their timeless wisdom that inspires us to strive always to better ourselves and our world around us. May they feel our love; see our sincerity and hear our praise in their honor. (pause for 2 count) Feel the presence of the Mighty Dead. (pause) Hear their whispers as we await their message.

(Rachael)

We send our love, honor and respect through the Sacred Fire into the heavens to the Shining Ones, Eldest and Wisest, it is their guidance and blessings we seek. May they feel our love, see our sincerity and hear our praise in their honor. (pause for 2 count) Feel the presence of the Shining Ones. (pause) Hear their whispers as we await their message.

During the Omen meditation above the AeonOHorus and Raven with take, interpret and pronounce the Omen. One Ogham is drawn for each of the three Kindred.

The horns are lifted saluting the fire, well and tree.

(Raven) Lugh, Bright Hero of the Tuatha, hallow these waters of life.

(Raven) Tailtiu, Great Goddess of Sovereignty, hallow these Waters of Life.

AeonOHorus lifts the horns before the participants.

(AeonOHorus) Behold the Waters of Life!

Drinking horns are passed and all participants share the waters. As the horns are passed the following song is sung by all participants.

(offering a final token (bannock) is offered upon the fire) May there be peace between us until we meet once again by the hearth's fire.

All: Lugh, we thank you!

(Raven) Crom Dubh, dark and bowed one. Old bull of the barren fields. We thank you for staying your hand until the final harvest is in.(offering a final token (bannock) is offered upon the fire) May there be peace between us until we meet once again by the hearth's fire.

(Sidhe Wolf) Let us now join our energy as one. See this energy as it flows throughout all who have gathered here this eve. See this energy as its power surges in us. Take of this energy what you need. (Pause for a 2 count)

(AeonOHorus) Let the energy that remains flow from us through our roots and our branches, returning to the Earth and Sky. See this energy as it travels to the Great Lake (pause). See this energy renew and restore that water that supports and surrounds us. See it heal and protect these waters as we conclude our worship. (Pause for a 4 count)

All: We will keep the faith until the sky falls upon us and crushes us; until the earth opens and swallows us; until the seas arises and overwhelm us.

(Carrion) Once more may we now raise our voices in song as we leave our Nemeton.
