Summer Solstice Ritual "Fire, Fire, Fire"

June 27, 2010

6:00 PM

PREPARATION

GROVE ATTUNEMENT

Joining our hands and closing our eyes, take a few deep cleansing breaths (pause 4 count). We now stand together upon the land, beneath the sky, surrounded by the sea as we prepare to enter sacred time (pause 4 count).

Below us flows the primal waters, cold, dark and chaotic; filled with the potential of all life. Reaching far beneath you into the earth, draw upon the waters of life. Feel them as they pool within your belly, within your heart and finally within your head. (pause 8 count)

Above us burns the primal fires, warm, light and ordered; filled with the spark of all life. Reaching far beyond the sky into the heavens, draw upon the fires of all creation. Feel them as they illuminate your mind, your heart and finally your spirit. (pause 8 count)

The fires of the heavens ignite the waters of the earth within you and you become one with the cosmos. Feel the primal powers of fire and water as they surge through you. Your heart beats with the very pulse of all worlds (pause 8 count)

We share our world with the Spirits of Nature. Our Fathers dwell in the Land of the Gods. The fire and water that flows through our veins sustains the worlds, the realms and the Kindred.

As we open our eyes let us be one in this place!

Musical Signal- Zills are used 9 times for the musical signal.

<u>Lighting of the Householder Fire</u>

The householder fire is lit.

Now get dressed in your robes, lord of powers and master of the sacrificial food, and offer this sacrifice for us.

When we offer sacrifice to this god or that god, in the full line of order, it is to you alone that the oblation is offered.

Let him be a beloved lord of tribes for us, a favourite, kindly invoker; let us have a good fire and be beloved.

For when the gods have a good fire, they bring us what we wish

for. Let us pray with a good fire. (O'Flaherty 100)

Honoring the Earth Mother and Sky Father

Sky and Earth,

the all knowing father and mother who achieve wondrous workslet them swell up with food to nourish us.

Let the two world-halves, that work together to give benefits to all, together trust toward us gain, and the victory prize, and wealth (O'Flaherty 206-07).

Clarified butter is offered upon the fire and milk to the Earth.

Establishing Sacred Time

GENERAL OFFERINGS TO AND INVOCATION OF THE SPIRITS

Now that the world of the living and that of the spirit are one, we call out from the crossroads to the Mighty Kindred!

In this Middle realm we share our world with many spirits. Creatures that have given their aid to humans since ancient times; providing transportation, food, and shelter to our Ancestors.

They serve our Gods and protect this sacred ground. Sacred tree and herb; mighty horse and bull; great eagle, Noble Ones we call to you.

Noble Spirits, accept our offering!

Seeds are offered.

Noble Spirits, Be Welcome Among Us!

Sit upon this strewn grass, O Yama, together with the fathers. Let the verses chanted by the poets carry you here. O King, rejoice in this oblation. Come Yama, with the Ancestors worthy of sacrifice:

Let our Ancestors all be worthy of soma-

Let us remain in favour with them, as they are worthy of sacrifice, and let them be helpful and kind. (O'Flaherty)

Grasses are spread before the Ancestor post.

You who were the first to invoke, rejoice in our friendship and hear only these songs.

So let praises flow back and forth between the two, between us who are mortals and you, the immortal.

Agni, young spawn of strength, with all the fires take pleasure in this sacrifice and in this speech. (O'Flaherty 100)

Through communication with the Otherworld;

We receive his guidance, inspiration and insight.

Tonight we call out from the crossroads to our guest of honor!

As we prepare to make our final sacrifice.

The final sacrifice is prepared.

It is in love, honor and respect that we have offered hospitality to Agni this day.

We have sung his praise; made our sacrifice.

It is our hope that our words and sacrifice have conveyed our love.

Agni, we honor you.

The final sacrifice is made.

THE OMEN

The Omen is taken by bowstrings. The seer then interprets the omen asking if our sacrifice and offerings have been accepted. The Seer then leads the company to contemplate the blessings/warnings of the omen from the Deity of the Occasion.

Kindred we thank you for the knowledge and blessings you have shared with us.(a final token of butter is offered to the fire). May there be peace between us until we meet once again by the hearth's fire.

All: Kindred, we thank you!

Wise Ones, may your words continue to be an inspiration to us. Mighty composer of eloquent praise, we thank for the blessings you have shared with us. (a final token of butter is offered to the fire) May there be peace between us until we meet once again by the hearth's fire.

All: Wise Ones, we thank you!

Indra, Mighty Warrior and Weilder of the Lightning Bolt; we thank you for your aid and protection this day. (a final token of butter is offered to the fire) May there be peace between us until we meet once again by the hearth's fire

Mighty Agni, may all that is be what was, that it may be again.

THANKING THE EARTH MOTHER AND SKY FATHER

Ancient Mystery of the Sky and Primal Mother of Earth, may you continue to grant us your blessings. Ancient Mother and Father, we thank you for all life(a final token of butter is offered to the fire) May there be peace between us until we meet once again by the hearth's fire.

All: Sky Father and Earth Mother, we thank you!

We now return all that has gone unused to the Earth and the Sky, may they continue to support, surround and sustain us. All offerings that remain are burnt in the fire or scattered upon the Earth.

STATEMENT OF ENDING

Good folk, join me once more as we close our eyes; breathing deeply in through your nose and out through your mouth (pause for a 2 count).

As we stand between Earth and Sky

Once more feel your feet firmly resting upon the Earth

Know that below us flows the primal waters.

Once more feel the coolness of the waters that have pooled within your belly, within your heart and finally, within your head.

(pause 4 count)

Reaching high into the sky above

Feel the illuminating radiance of the Heavens.

Know that above us burns the primal fires.

Once more feel the warmth of the fires that have illuminated your mind, your heart and finally your spirit. (pause 4 count)

Feel the primal powers of Earth and Sky surging through you, as they have given strength and energy to your being. (pause 4 count)

Keep of this power what you need, sending what remains forth from our beings into this land (pause). See this energy heal and protect her as we conclude our worship.

Musical Signal- Zills are used 9 times for the musical signal.

All: We will keep the faith until the sky falls upon us and crushes us; until the earth opens and swallows us; until the seas arises and overwhelm us.
