Call to them, honor them for their protection and blessings they provide and invite them to join you as you celebrate Earth Day. Make an offering that you feel would be appropriate. You may also choose to honor and make offering to a personal patron(s) and invite them to join in the celebration. The following text is optional for non-Whispering Lake Grove members.

# **Attunement**

I join my heart and mind with others who gather this day to celebrate Earth Day. (*Taking a few deep cleansing breaths*) I stand within Midgard, upon the land, beneath the sky, surrounded by the sea as I prepare to stand at the center of all worlds.

Below me flows the primal waters, cold, dark and chaotic; filled with the potential of all life. Reaching far beneath me into the earth, I draw upon the waters of life. I feel these waters rise within me, pooling within my belly, rising higher, they pool within my heart and finally within my head. (pause).

Above me burns the primal fires, warm, light and ordered; filled with the spark of all life. Reaching far beyond the sky into the heavens, I draw upon the power that sparks all creation. I feel this power enter my being, igniting the fire in my head, warming the cauldron of my heart and finally, illuminating my spirit. (pause)

The fires of the heavens ignite the waters of the earth within me and I become one with the cosmos. I feel the primal powers of fire and water as they surge through me. My heart beats with the very pulse of all worlds (pause)

I am reminded that I share this world with the Spirits of Nature, that my Ancestors dwell in the Halls of the Gods and that I am all cradled in the branches of the Yggdrasill. The fire and water that flows through my veins sustains the worlds, the realms and the Kindred.

Let me be one with the cosmos and the Kindred in this place. May I be prepared for this work, let me now recreate the cosmos!

The waters support and surround me,

Sacred waters fill this well with your healing magic!

(an offering is made to the well)

The land extends about me.

Sacred tree let the words spoken here resonate throughout the worlds!

(the tree is asperged and sensed)

The sky stretches above me,

Sacred fire burn with the power of transformation!

(an offering is made to the fire)

For at this center burns a living flame,

All:

Let me pray with a good fire,

May all the Kindred bless me,

May my worship be true

May my actions be just

May my love be pure.

Blessings, honor and worship to the holy ones.

## **OUTDWELLERS**

Within me dwells forces that bring chaos into my life, those influences that pollute my heart and mind. (pause in reflection)

These powers also dwell in others, within the worlds, realms and among the Kindred. They threaten our world, our work and our lives.

Let me remember the forces and Beings that stand against the Gods and humankind.

Let me remember the strife that they bring, while recognizing their power, influence and purpose in the cosmos. (pause)

With this token (a token is held before the fire, well and tree. This token should be sometime offered to no other being in the ritual. Dark offerings in the form of burnt bread, toast, bannocks, dark alcohol are most appropriate) may I seek to end any unhealthy relationships with these forces.

(A token is laid beyond the ritual space in silence)
May I be free from the chaos that could overwhelm me!

Let it be so!

Participants should take water from their wells and incense lit from the sacred fire and cense and asperge their shrine, ritual area and person.

Musical Signal: A hammer strikes and anvil 3X3 times or any musical signal you choose. You can use anything that makes a sound. Could be as simple as a potlid and a spoon or knocking with a staff on the floor, if you don't have a hammar/avil, drum, singing bowl, whistle etc.

## **PROCESSION**

# (can be spoken or sung)

Earth Mother, I sing to your body, Earth Mother, I sing to your bones, Earth Mother, I honor your body, Earth Mother, I honor your stones. (lyrics and music written by an unknown author)

Primal Mother of the Earth and Father of the Clear Sky, Forever, Mother and Father of all that was, of all that is and all that will be. Your child comes before you in love and respect and asks that you uphold and bless my gathering!

An offering is made to the Earth Mother & Sky Father.

Earth Mother and Sky Father accept my offering!

# **STATEMENT OF PURPOSE**

A child of Earth and Sky gathers in this sacred place to celebrate Earth Day, to give honor and make sacrifice to the Earth Mother(s). This day I will keep the Old Bargain, seeking the blessings, wisdom and guidance of the Earth Mother(s) in return. May all who gather be welcome!

## INVOCATION TO THE GATEKEEPER

Oh, Ancient Ones of Might and Magic, I call to Eldest and Wisest of the Worlds, I seek a Priest of the Sacred Fire...

To aid me in my work...

To join their magic with my own...

And open the way between the worlds.

An offering is made to the Gatekeeper

Fire Priest accept my offering!

# **OPENING THE GATES**

Fire Priest; let me stand at the center of all worlds! Sacred Fires ignite the waters of the earth. Primal Waters feed the order of the cosmos. World Tree join the heavens with the earth. Striking a sigil over the fire.

Let these flames carry my praise and sacrifice to the Shining Ones. *Striking a sigil over the well.* 

Let these waters carry my praise and sacrifice to the Mighty Dead. *Striking a sigil upon the tree.* 

Let this tree connect the worlds as they become one in this place.

By the land before me!

Let the Gates Be Open!

I now stand at the center of all worlds!

## PRAYER OF SACRIFICE

Through my praise, love and sacrifice,

I honor the Ancient One of Ever-Changing Beauty. It is through my work and sacrifice that I receive her guidance, wisdom and blessings. Tonight, I call out once more from the center of all worlds to the

Mother(s) of the Earth that she may heal my world, bless my work and my life, as I prepare to make my sacrifice.

Make an oath, promise, or give a gift to the Earth Mother(s) that will benefit the Earth, Nature or Both in the Spirit of Earth Day. If the gift is not given immediately, please make the oath or promise and have the gift at least started by May 1<sup>st</sup> in Her honor. Ideas for this sacrifice might include, but are certainly not limited to, beginning recycling in your home, establishing a shrine where you make regular offerings to the Earth Mother, cleaning up land or planting something etc.

## THE OMEN

The omen is taken in a symbol set of the participants choosing and if you are without a symbol set, sit in meditation to attempt to obtain an answer.

## **BLESSING OF THE WATERS**

The following words will be spoken over a cup.

As in the ways of old I have given my gifts freely and as in the ways of old a gift is given unto me in return.

I will drink deep of the Cup of Inspiration. May

the blessings of health, wealth and wisdom be mine.

Earth Mother(s) give me the waters!

I gather with you between Earth and Sky. I am proud to call myself a child of the Earth.

Earth Mother(s) give me the waters!

I have brought my offerings and made my sacrifice.

Earth Mother(s) give us the waters!

The cup is lifted saluting the fire, well and tree.

## Hallowing the Waters

Primal Mother(s) of the Earth hear and bless me. Great Goddess of Life and Light, hallow these Waters of Life. The cup is lifted before your shrine. Behold the Waters of Life!

### AFFIRMATION OF THE BLESSINGS

Ask yourself, "do you wish to receive the blessings of the Earth Mother(s)? If the answer is yes, drink deep her blessings. If the answer is no, thank the Earth Mother(s) and end the ritual, kissing the cup and pouring the blessings in offering.

"Blessings of the Holy Ones".

# STATEMENT OF ENDING

(Once more take a few deep cleansing breaths as you reaffirm our center). I stand at the center of all worlds, upon the land, beneath the sky, surrounded by the sea. I span the worlds, connecting earth and sky and the Kindred as one (pause).

I remember that below me flows the primal waters filled with the potential of all life. It is these waters that surge through my very being. (*pause*)

I remember that above me burns the primal fires filled with the spark of all life. It is these powers that have illuminated the waters that surge through me. (*pause*)

The primal powers of fire and water unite within me bringing new life and balance to my being. My heart beats with the very pulse of all worlds (*pause*)

I remember that I share these worlds with the Spirits of Nature, with the Ancestors and with the Gods. As they bless me, offer their wisdom and guidance let me forever remember the old bargain.

I remember the powers of earth and sky, the sacred fire and waters, that flow within me... (pause and take what you need to maintain balance and release back to the earth and sky all that has gone unused) I know that the fire and water that flows from me helps to sustains the worlds, the realms and the Kindred as I conclude myu worship.

May all that is be what was, that it may be again!

Musical Signal- A hammer strikes and anvil 3X3 or other signal. Remember to thank all of your personal beings invited at the beginning of the work and your personal spirits of hearth and home.

Manannan, I thank you for aiding me in my work, joining me at my hearth and walking with me as I journey upon my path. (*a final token is offered*) May there be peace between us always.

Manannan, I thank you!

I will keep the faith until the sky falls upon me and crushes me; until the earth opens and swallows me; until the seas arises and overwhelm me.
