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# The Story of Lugh's arrival to Tara Part 1 (Raven)

The procession is halted at the entrance to the Nemeton as all in attendance here the retelling of Lugh's arrival to the gates of Tara. Once the story is ended the procession continues into the ritual area.

Processional chant continues following the story until all have entered the nemeton.

### **GROVE ATTUNEMENT (Carrion)**

Closing your eyes, take a few deep, cleansing breaths.

As you breathe, lay aside the worries, troubles, and woes of the mundane world. (pause 4 count)

Return with me to the beginning of the cosmos, a time when there was but the fire of the Sky and the waters of the Earth and between them lay only vast emptiness. (*pause 4 count*)

Today we exist together between the waters of the Earth and the fire of the Sky, in the very place where all things begin and end and the center of all is created.

Within this vast emptiness the illuminating power of the first fire and the creative potential of the waters begin to draw toward each other, converging upon the center. The waters flow around you, cradle you and cleanse you. Reach out to this primal power and begin to draw these waters into your being. This power is cool, dark and chaotic, filled with the potential of all life.

The illuminating radiance of the fire glows around you, warms you and purifies you. Reach out to the primal power draw it into your being. This power is warm, light and ordered, filled with the spark of all life.

The fire and water converge around you and within you. The fire of the Sky ignites the waters of the Earth, enlivening your spirit and bringing forth life anew around you.

You turn your attention outward from the center to see the sacred tree that grows within the Middle realm before you its roots reaching deep within the Earth to the Underworld and branches extending through the Sky and into the Heavens; connecting all realms.

Feel the land that extends below you, forming a firm foundation beneath your feet. See the sky stretches above you. Feel the sea that supports and surrounds you.

The union of fire and water is the life force. It is the power and potential that creates and renews the cosmos. It connects the worlds, the realms, and the Kindred all as it flows through each of us.

Join your hands, your hearts, and your minds with those around you. Feel the power and potential that flows through us. The sacred waters flow within us. The sacred fire burns within us and the sacred tree grows within us.

As we open our eyes, know that we are one with the cosmos. Let us raise our voices in song as we hallow the center of the worlds.

Each participant has been given a title of Lugh. Following Carrion beginning the invocation each participate will call out to Lugh using the title they have been given. When the last person has made their call Carrion will complete the invocation and make the offering.

# FINAL SACRIFICE (All)

A slow drumbeat begins. Other participants will take up shakers, and other instruments or participate in dancing and intoning to raise magical energy for the Beings of the Occasion. The Seer will collect and direct the energy through the gate and communicate with the being of the occasion. He/she will take an omen by drawing either Nauthiz, representing the need to continue or Gebo represent our gift for a gift and the acceptance of our sacrifice. The assembled company will raise energy until the final sacrifice has been accepted. The Seer will then conclude the energy raising with "Our Sacrifice has been Accepted" followed by **Carrion** saying: "Lugh give us the waters!" X3 in a call and response with all assembled.

# THE OMEN & BLESSING OF THE WATERS

#### (Carrion)

The officiant takes up the blessing cups and infuses them with the power returning from the gateway. Once the blessings have been infused, he/she will raise the cups and pronounce "Behold the Waters of Life" all assembled will echo "Behold the Waters of Life". *The waters will be passed*. The officiate will then say that these cups contain the blessings of Lugh. *Do you wish to receive the blessings of Lugh?* Participant's response. *Do you wish to receive the blessings of Lugh?* Participant's response. Then let us share all he has offered to us.

As the blessings are passed **Grollwynn** will lead the chant, "Blessings of the Holy Ones". While the blessings are being passed the Seer will be taking an omen to determine our blessings.

The omen will be pronounced by **Raven** for the folk. Each of the three runes drawn will be pronounced one at a time. The first will be pronounced, the meaning and interpretation given. **Carrion** will then lead the company to intone the runes. The second will be pronounced, followed by its meaning and then intonation etc. The Seer will offer any final interpretation.
